Measurement	Where To Measure	My Dog's Measurement
Neck measurement	Around the base of the neck, where the collar sits	
Chest girth	Around the widest part of the chest, just behind the front legs	
Back length	From the base of the neck to the base of the tail	
Front leg opening	Around the top of the front leg	
Distance between front legs	Across the front chest area, if needed	
Dog's height	From the floor to the shoulder blades/withers	
Belly length	From chest to where sweater should stop underneath	

Fit Notes

- ☐ Neck has two fingers of space
- ☐ Chest has enough room
- ☐ Front legs can move freely
- ☐ Sweater does not pull across the chest
- ☐ Belly area allows bathroom breaks
- ☐ Dog can walk, sit, and lie down comfortably
- ☐ Back length stops before the base of the tail
